



CLASP HAND VIOLATION November 1, 2013



It is a clasp hand violation around the tube of the body or both legs. With one or both arms included the locked hands below the crown of the shoulder is around the tube of the body. The same is true with a lower extremity included. It is still a clasp hand violation when the lock hands are completely above the round of the rump, behind the bend of the knee joint. When the thigh area of the leg is included in the lock hands and the buttocks is completely visible it is an illegal clasp hand violation. If the clasp is below the round of the rump it is not around the tube of the body and is merely a lock around a single leg (which is legal).
